



4 STEPS

to re-open Chapel Hill

With the health and safety of all our Chapel Hill families in mind, we are following the guidelines of biblical truth and scientific input in making plans for future gatherings. These plans are contingent on the overall health of our local community and state.

1

Today and the coming few weeks:

- Worship services, LifeGroups, Alpha, Celebrate Recovery, and programming for children, students, and others will continue online.
- The church building will remain closed to staff and visitors.

2

Same as Step 1 plus:

- Staff who are not at risk may return to work in the building, following specific guidelines to ensure strict social distancing, proper cleaning, and mutual protection.

3

Same as Steps 1-2 plus:

- Gatherings of 50 or fewer may meet, following specific guidelines to ensure strict social distancing and mutual protection. We encourage those who are at risk to meet via Zoom, as well as those who are more comfortable meeting online.
- We will schedule and approve on-campus gatherings on a case-by-case basis so we can maintain cleaning protocols and ensure the health and safety of anyone meeting in the building.
- LifeGroups can meet in homes and worship together following best-practice guidelines.
- The church building will be open to visitors.

4

Possibly September:

- We will resume in-person church services and programming, although everyone will practice social distancing.
- The church building will re-open to the public and for outside group events and meetings with scheduling and programming relying on best practices protocol.
- Online worship services and appropriate church programming will continue to be offered.
