1. **Where do we go to understand?**

-search the scriptures - stick to what the scriptures say

- James 5:13-16
- Mark 9:14-29
- John 9:1-12
- Revelation 21:3-4
- Matthew 7:7-8



HEART

2. **What questions does this cause you to ask?**

-acknowledge the struggle - do not attempt to answer now

- Then why is my friend dying?
- I can't see God. How do I know He's there?
- How do I know my prayers will work?
- What if God doesn't answer my prayer?

3. **How do the scriptures above help as you wrestle through your questions?**

-invite the Spirit into the mystery—use your Bible study to wrestle
