HAITI 2018 World Relief-Haiti Trip at a Glance



- Who? A Go Team to come alongside our church partner, World Relief-Haiti, to learn about their work with local churches and their Church Empowerment Zone model to address the needs of the poor and most vulnerable in a comprehensive and holistic manner. Seeking team members with strong interpersonal skills with a heart to learn and serve as "bridges" between Chapel Hill and partners at World Relief-Haiti.
- What? We will be seeing what the Lord is doing through the Haitian church, further understanding models of excellent Relief and Development work, and growing our friendship with the staff at World Relief. Other highlights will likely include participating in an all-night prayer service, touring a fair trade workshop that supplies some of the products we sell at the Festival of Hope, and jointly hosting/participating in a retreat for the World Relief staff/Chapel Hill team.
- Where? The trip will be based in Haiti's capital, Port-au-Prince, but is tentatively planning to also spend several days in the western region of the country visiting World Relief's work in the areas most affected by recent hurricanes.
- When? Approximate Dates May 4-13, 2018 (dates may change by 1-2 days depending on flights)
- **Cost?** \$1600-\$1800 (Fundraising coaching provided) This cost includes flights, medical insurance, food and housing in-country, all transportation, and host fees.
