Who?	40-50 men of all ages interested in doing construction and relational ministry in a cross- cultural context.
What?	<ul> <li>Agua Viva Ministries exists to reach Mexico for Christ through four strategies:</li> <li>1. A seminary and Bible school that trains pastors, missionaries, and lay people to better equip the Mexican church.</li> <li>2. A camping facility where Mexican churches hold retreats, seminars, and other events at an affordable rate.</li> <li>3. Church planting and missionary support to unreached people groups in Mexico.</li> <li>4. Partnerships with U.S. and Canadian teams to share Christ's love through short-term mission opportunities.</li> </ul>
	The Chapel Hill Men's team will be working alongside local churches and our partners at Agua Viva on several construction sites and in 2-3 relationship-building ministries (which are likely to include rehab centers and a homeless ministry). The men will also be hosting an appreciation dinner for the Agua Viva staff and seminary students.

Where?	Agua Viva is 35 minutes east of Ensenada, Mexico (a coastal city of 260,000 people 80 miles south of San Diego).
Why?	To grow in each man's relationship with God, one another, and our brothers and sisters in the Mexican church as we come alongside the poor in Jesus' name.
